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Building Report December 2017 BOE Meeting

MTSS Implementation: Progress monitoring began at SES on Wednesday, November 15. Students receiving Tier 2/Tier 3 interventions completed assessment probes in the areas of reading and math. Additional probes will be given every other week for reading, and every three weeks in math. This data will be reviewed at the PLC meeting scheduled for December 8 to evaluate student progress and intervention effectiveness. In addition, the testing window for the Fastbridge winter benchmark screening is November 29-December 15. Students will complete screeners in both reading and math. Teachers will also complete the SAEBRS behavioral screener for their homeroom students. Screening data will be reviewed by staff members during the January 15th district inservice.



3rd Grade Music Performance: On November 14, our 3rd graders performed at the Buzz Café for the Christian Women's November meeting. They performed some songs that were included in their Veteran's Day program.

1st Grade Guest Speaker: On November 14, SHS senior Samantha Edwards presented information regarding birds of prey to the entire first grade class. This presentation was part of her activities connected to earning the Girl Scouts Gold Award. Students were informed about the various attributes that distinguish birds of prey, those they might find in the local area, and what people can do to help sustain the birds natural habitats. Each child also received bird seed and informational cards.
