**Innovative Learning Opportunities**  
 Mrs. Walker- Early Childhood: "Toys that Teach" I use this project as a culminating activity after weeks of studying each age group: infants, toddlers, preschoolers, and school-age children. The students are asked to design, build, and demonstrate an original homemade toy which provides learning and play for either an individual child or a small group of children. The toy is to be constructed of common everyday household items, meet safety guidelines, and be easy to carry and use. The Toy Design Worksheet asks the student to identify developmental and educational needs met by the use of the toy.
