MTSS: Grade level groups met again at the PLC (Professional Learning Community) and continued conversations about implementation of progress monitoring in Reading and Math for intervention groups. We also looked our behavioral/social emotional data and discussed possible individual support in the area of social-emotional learning. Guiding questions were: Are students making progress? Are interventions working? How will we continue to use the data? We are currently administering the Winter Fastbridge Screeners. We also looked at our behavior/social emotional data and broke it down to identify where we need to make improvements in Tier 1 for implementing the teaching and reinforcing expectations and correcting behaviors. We also began discussions regarding school climate/culture.
